<u>5: Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC) Member Recruitment FY</u> 2024/25

BCAG's Associate Planner discussed the annual recruitment of the Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC).

The SSTAC is a three-year term in which the council will advise on transportation needs.

Recruitment opportunities and information was made available to the public via B-Line fixed route bus advertisement, local and surrounding area newspapers, social media, and targeted emails.

SSTAC recruitment will take place June 10, 2024 through July 12, 2024.

6: Butte Regional Transit Outreach

BCAG's Assistant Planner informed the Board regarding past outreach events in the community, along with future events staff will be attending.

In an effort to engage the community about public transportation in Butte County, staff will continue to participate in community outreach events.

BCAG staff remains diligent in its continued efforts to assess and improve shelters and stops with appropriate upgrades throughout the county.

7: Butte Regional Transit Marketing

BCAG Transit Manager spoke with the Board regarding current and upcoming Butte Regional Transit Marketing plans. This included vehicles, mobile ticket upgrade, micro transit, routing changes, and non-emergency medical transportation.

Butte Regional Transit will be introducing new, diesel and zero-emission, freightliner buses in late August 2024 and late 2025. The freightliner addition will also include a revised color scheme as a part of marketing efforts.

BCAG staff informed the Board they will contract with a consultant to prepare a marketing Plan and distribute materials to promote new transit services.

8: Hydrogen Fueling Station Specifications Request for Proposals

BCAG Executive Director presented the Board with plans to roll out the mandated Innovative Clean Technologies (ICT) regulation conversion, following the policy of California Air Resources Board (CARB).

BCAG anticipates the Butte Regional Transit fleet to be 100% zero emissions fleet. A Rollout Plan was completed by staff in September 2023.

Staff released a Request for Proposals on June 11th, 2024, to secure a consultant that will be utilized on The Rollout Plan. Proposals are due in mid-July, and work is expected to begin late August.
